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## 1 Public summary

The implementation of a comprehensive audit procedure, which is systematic and objective, enables the public transport operator (PTO) to conduct essential inspections regarding the performance of security arrangements.

This document provides guidance and documents for such a comprehensive audit procedure, and for systematic and objective inspections regarding the performance of security arrangements. It is based on the methodology described in D31.1 - Security Preparedness Handbook. Organisational Procedures – Security Audits, Monitoring and Control and contains guidance in the form of generic procedures in several chapters, each identifying issues a public transport operator has to consider, when preparing, implementing, evaluating and reinforcing own audits.

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
