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1 Public Summary

The purpose of deliverable D52.5 is to describe experiences made and results obtained through application of SECUR-ED methodologies for security audit (D51.1) and risk assessment (D31.2). The report covers both evaluation of the usability of the methodologies for medium sized/small operators, experiences on how to employ the methodologies to obtain efficient and high quality results (do's and don'ts), and summaries describing potential security gaps/problems disclosed through application of the methods.

In accordance with the framework for the task the risk assessment and security audits as well as the following evaluation, have addressed malicious human actions (not accidental events) with focus on both habitual crime and acts of terrorism.

To fulfill the work package's objectives, several additional cities have been selected for conducting risk assessments and security audits in order to identify security gaps, and to evaluate possible solutions/capacities to mitigate these shortcomings. The cities selected are Bergen, Bilbao, Krakow, Gaziantep and Flensburg.

Some of these cities will become satellite demonstration cities where the most promising security capacities will be tested and evaluated.

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
