1 Public Summary

This document represents SECUR-ED deliverable D01.8, providing a status of all the ethical aspects treated within SECUR-ED, during the second project period (April 2012 to July 2013).

Starting from what is written in the Grant Agreement, several improvements have been made during period P1 in order to better address the ethical and societal issues which might become critical in a security demonstration project and are scrutinized by the European Commission.

This ethical and societal impact policy has been applied during period P2, following two main axes:

- A deep involvement of the Advisory Group for Ethical and Societal issues in the project, reviewing deliverables, providing ethical assessment of proposed capacities, and participating in the main project meetings, such as the mid-term conference.
- A strong enforcement of the rules applicable to the demonstrations, with the appointment of ethical correspondents for each demo, who are ensuring that the demonstration is prepared in accordance with the ethical checklist and broader ethical concerns associated with privacy, human rights and so on.
