1 Public Summary

This deliverable describes the Scenarios that will be developed in Berlin as part of the SECUR-ED project in European Commission Framework Programme 7th.

At the Berlin demonstration of the SECUR-ED project, the focus will not be on technology but on providing security training for employees.

This is because employees are a key part of security. Technology alone cannot replace company staff. This deliverable will describe a selection of modules and methods which will be implemented and tested in Berlin in actual training sessions. The material for the demonstration will have to be translated into German and modified to make it appropriate to the situation at Deutsche Bahn AG.

This demonstration will provide an opportunity to assess the project content, training materials and effectiveness, because only assessing skills gaps beforehand can determine whether any knowledge gaps have been closed and response to situations improved, thereby increasing security for the transport operator.

This deliverable will also describe the approach and the necessary framework for the Berlin demonstration.
