# 1 Public Summary

This document is the second deliverable produced by SECUR-ED WP55 (Best Practices Materials) as part of task 55.2 (Review of reference material).

As stated in the SECUR-ED project Description of Work, the WP55 team had to go through all capacities covered by the SECUR-ED project demonstrations, in order to establish the answers to “how, when, where, what and by who” best practices at PT system level.

Best practices will have four common characteristics:

- ➔ To be innovative, but proven as per WP54 “Performance Benchmarking”
- ➔ To make a difference as to improve the security level
- ➔ To have a sustainable effect as being industrial and maintainable over the transit system life cycle
- ➔ To have the potential to be generic enough in order to serve as a model for generating initiatives elsewhere (instantiation).

Specifically, deliverable D55.2 presents the results of WP55 task 55.2, aiming at:

- ➔ Review the conditions in which each capacity has been used
- ➔ Recommend how to get best use of each capacity
- ➔ Warn about possible misuse of each capacity.
