1 Abstract & Purpose

1.1 Summary

During the life time of SECUR-ED, the main dissemination activities of SECUR-ED were carefully recorded on the Cooperation Tool of the project as well as in the database of the European Commission.

In Annex I the dissemination activities of SECUR-ED are listed as requested by the Description of Work.

Over its life time SECUR-ED published 4 press releases, 15 publications (a very high number for a demonstration project), and had 6 articles in the press. It was present at major international fairs such as the UITP World Congress and Exhibition and INNOTRANS, and was presented in 55 events.

1.2 Purpose of the document

The document is intended to give a brief overview of SECUR-ED dissemination and to provide a detailed list of the external SECUR-ED dissemination activities (see Annex I).

2 Purpose and Structure of SECUR-ED Dissemination

Following the principles laid out in the SECUR-ED Master Plan for Dissemination, the main purpose of SECUR-ED dissemination was to prepare and to contribute to the exploitation of the results of the project. For this, the project had to reach out and engage with the principal stakeholders in public transport security. Following the project's objective of improving the security of public transport in Europe this included first and foremost a dialogue with public transport authorities and operators. To reach these, SECUR-ED focused on the membership of UITP's Security Commission but also communicated to the wider UITP membership, for instance by featuring the project in UITP newsletters. The project also reached out to first responders and public authorities to improve the security of public transport.

The second objective of SECUR-ED was to enlarge the market for the European security industry. Here, the project relied on EOS and UNIFE as well as all partners, in particular the demonstration partners, to act as multipliers and additionally engaged with the European standardisation bodies to ensure an effective exploitation of SECUR-ED results.

SECUR-ED dissemination was structured in three phases. In the first phase SECUR-ED had to be made known. The project achieved this through presentations, the presence at fairs with stands, and press articles in which the project was described and the demos were announced.

The second phase focused on the demos. Around all demonstrations, the Final demonstration events were organised and those relevant stakeholders that were not part of a demo were invited to attend as guests and observers. The demo workshops were an excellent way of raising the awareness for the SECUR-ED project and to show the results it can deliver.

The third phase is the exploitation of the results. The SECUR-ED project has put everything in place to make an efficient exploitation possible: Tool kits were prepared, instructions on result exploitations were provided through:

- the deliverables,
- the specific handbooks,
- the white papers (gathering the latest conclusions and recommendations established during the workshops),
- the scientific publications (as many scientific papers have been submitted only at the end of the Project a final list will be included in D01.9 and D01.11).

SECUR-ED fed into the European standardisation process. This legacy will make exploitation of results possible also after the end of the project.

2.1 Key Dissemination Events

SECUR-ED paid attention that the project would receive good coverage in the security and public transport related press. SECUR-ED could place four press releases and was present with six articles in the press and a further article is announced for the end of the project. Furthermore, fifteen academic publications came out of the project. This number is very high for a demonstration project which does not focus on research and development.

SECUR-ED was presented at 55 different conferences with presentations. These included for instance the Transport and Security Expo conference but also presentations to the EC Land Security Expert Group.

SECUR-ED was present at relevant security and public transport related fairs. These included the Transport and Research Area, the French Transport Publics, the Transport and Security Expo in London, twice the INNOTRANS fair in Berlin and also the UITP World Congress and Exhibition and IT-TRANS. These were good opportunities to showcase the latest developments in the project and to enlarge the audience and the coverage of the advisory groups.

The meetings of the Advisory Groups can also be counted towards the key dissemination events. Experts on public transport operations, from the security industry, from first responders as well as ethical and legal experts met regularly to advise the project. They did however not only provide input to the project but – having diverse backgrounds and a dense network in the field of security and transport – they were also important multipliers for SECUR-ED. The advisory groups met twice yearly.

For all demonstrations (except for Bergen) conferences were organised during which the demonstrations could be witnessed. These conferences were open to the relevant public and were well attended. They represented key dissemination opportunities as during these conferences stakeholders could experiences directly what SECUR-ED did for public transport security.

Finally, SECUR-ED organised two main conferences: the midterm conference and the final conference. The midterm conference, held in May 2013 in conjunction with the UITP World Congress, was attended by around 90 participants from the world over and included an exhibition where several of the security capacities of SECUR-ED were displayed. The final conference in Brussels was even larger, with more than 110 participants. As during the midterm conference, a number of security solutions were displayed to give the conference attendees a real-life impression of SECUR-ED.

2.2 Tools for Dissemination

SECUR-ED relied on several tools for its dissemination. An important tool was of course the website www.secur-ed.eu which was regularly updated and which the project monitored with Google Analytics. The website will stay online for two more years after the end of the project.

Additionally, the project prepared three newsletters for dissemination, a project leaflet, and it was featured in the internal publications of UITP and UNIFE.

As mentioned above, the Advisory Groups were also used as a regular means of dissemination. In the bi-yearly meetings the Advisory Group members were brought together for discussions and exchange giving them the most up-to-date status of the project.

SECUR-ED also produced six videos in order to ensure dissemination after the end of the project. The videos summarise the activities of SECUR-ED and guide the viewers through the project. These videos can be found on the final USB key and on the project's website.
